First and foremost, Thank You all, for once again, coming out to vote and pass our budget for the upcoming fiscal year. With a staff that embraces continuing ed, supervisors that challenge themselves to meet patron needs and a building that we are ever improving, we are squeezing every nickel's worth from the tax levy. 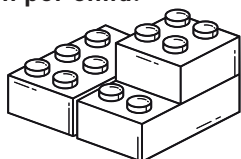

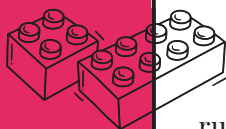

Learn how strings can bring puppets to life. Each child will learn the core principles of string puppet construction and performance, and use them to create an original character.



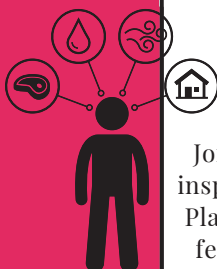
Roblox® Adventure:
